 - I recruited coaches with experience in jazz and New Orleans brass band music. We had a group comprised primarily of young professional musicians who were inexperienced in jazz music. This included many music education graduates seeking professional development.

 - I worked as the brass clinician for the marching band.
- Denham Springs Community Jazz Band, 2013-2015
 - I founded this community ensemble in Denham Springs, Louisiana.
 - I conducted this ensemble, as well as selecting coaches who were experienced in big band jazz music. This ensemble grew to roughly forty members, which led me to split it into two bands. The local high school took notice of how many of their students were enrolled in the program and elected to revive the jazz ensemble class because of the demonstrated interest from their student body.

 - I worked as a tech for the concert and marching band.
 - I directed the indoor marching band in its inaugural season.
 - I coached private and small group lessons on trumpet, horn and low brass.
- Fontainebleau High School, 2010-2013
 - I worked as the brass clinician for the marching band and led sectionals as well as small group lessons with more advanced players.

- I also worked with the jazz ensemble, especially the trumpet section.
- I taught private lessons to about 20 trumpet players as well as several low brass students.
- Private Instruction, 2010- present
 - I have taught over 100 trumpet students ranging from beginners to established professionals.
 - I have coached many of my professional peers on branching into lead trumpet work safely and without extensively modifying their current playing styles.
 - Although my highest-level teaching ability is for the trumpet, my ability as a multi-instrumentalist has helped me to coach dozens of students on various instruments.
 - I also specialize in helping classically trained players cross into playing jazz while maintaining the integrity of their developed classical sound.
